

## Managing (Dis)Honorable Guests - Roles for Grid Security

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As a result of the past several years focus on authentication tools and infrastructure, we now have operable means to globally identify a grid actor, authenticate them and establish their VO membership. However, we still are in the common position that a person has only one set of privileges. Distributed management of Grid authorization remains a significant challenge. This talk will discuss a proposal for taking first steps in establishing basic common roles (and their corresponding privileges on resources). Further, I will review recent work within the Grid Interoperation Now (GIN) group at GGF to establish interoperation of identity and authentication underpinnings.
